RENEWABLE PARALLEL SERVICE

AVAILABLE

At locations on the Company's existing secondary distribution facilities.

APPLICABLE

To residential or general service Customers (M and W Systems) who are supplied at one point of delivery, and where a part or all of the electrical requirements of the Customer can be supplied from a renewable source other than the Company, and where such source is connected for parallel operation of the Customer's system with the service of the Company. Customer renewable generation sources may include, but are not limited to, wind turbines, hydroelectric plants, solar conversion and geothermal devices. Customer's source under this schedule is limited to the maximum kilowatt capacity as stipulated by Kansas legislative statute. As of July 2007, K.S.A. 66-1,184(b)(2) stipulates that the maximum kilowatt capacity is 25 kW for residential Customers and 200 kW for commercial Customers. Such generator shall be appropriately sized for each Customer's anticipated electric load.

A commercial Customer who uses the operation of a renewable generator in connection with irrigation pumps shall not request more than 10 irrigation pumps connected to renewable generators be attached or connected to the utility's system.

The Company may limit the number and size of renewable generators to be connected to the Company's system due to the capacity of the distribution line to which such renewable generator would be connected, and in no case shall the Company be obligated to purchase an amount greater than 4% of the Company's peak power requirements.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Alternating current, 60 cycles, at the voltage and phase of the Company's established secondary distribution system most available to the location of the Customer.

MONTHLY RATE

1. For capacity and energy supplied by Company to Customer, the applicable rate will apply.
2. For energy supplied by the Customer to the Company, the rate paid will be 150% (one hundred fifty percent) of the actual cost of purchased energy and the fossil fuel burned in generation as calculated in the most recent Energy Cost Adjustment (ECA) filing for the period(s) in which the energy was delivered to the Company.
