
SECTION 10 – GENERAL CLAUSES

A. WAIVER

Waiver by the Company with respect to any default by a Customer in complying with the provisions of the Electric Service Agreement and these Terms and Conditions will not be deemed to be a waiver with respect to any other or subsequent default by such Customer.

B. LEGAL NOTICES BETWEEN CUSTOMER AND COMPANY

All notices addressed to the Company will be in writing and no telephone communication will be considered as proper notice unless otherwise specifically provided for in these Terms and Conditions.

C. AUTHORITY AND WAIVER

The requirements contained in these Terms and Conditions may be waived in individual cases at Company's discretion upon request by the Customer and a determination that compliance with the requirement would serve the interests of neither the Company nor the Customer. No representative, agent, or employee of the Company below the level of Vice President will otherwise have the authority to amend, modify, alter, or waive any of Company's Terms and Conditions or bind the Company by promises or representations, written or oral.
