Midwest Energy, Inc. is seeking qualified distributors and/or manufacturers to provide material for a 25-mile 115kV transmission line rebuild project. This project is being partially funded by the Department of Energy (DOE) through the Grid Resilience and Innovation Partnership (GRIP) program. Therefore, all materials, unless approved by a waiver, must comply with the Build America, Buy America Act (BABAA) requirements set forth in Pub. L. No. 117-58, §§ 70901-52. Bidders must accept Code of Federal Regulations 2 CFR Part 200 Appendix II provisions applicable to this purchase transaction.

Midwest Energy will accept bids from distributors and/or manufacturers for the material they can provide the required information for.

- 2. All bids are required to be firm fixed-price and need to be submitted with unit pricing. All bids must include freight and any other additional charges.
- 3. The required material list that is posted on Midwest Energy's website has been assembled using one manufacturer per item and that manufacturer's catalog number associated with that item. Midwest Energy believes that the manufacturer listed for each item is a source of BABAA compliant material. However, Midwest Energy will accept quotes from other manufacturers that are not on the list if the item is equivalent in design and meets the BABAA requirements.
- 4. BABAA certifications must be submitted with the bid for all material.
