TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Company will supply, own and maintain at as expense all necessary meters and associated equipment utilized for billing, addition, and for purposes of monitoring Customer generation and load, the company may install load research metering at its expense. The Customer shall supply, at no expense to the Company, a suitable location for meters and associated equipment shall be accessible at all times to utility ansonnel.
- 2. The Company shall have the right to require the Customer, at certain times and as electric operating conditions warrant, to limit the production of electrical energy from the generating facility to an amount no greater than the load at the Customer's facility of which the generating facility is a part.
- 3. The Customer shall furnish, install, operate and maintain in good order and repair without cost to the Company such relays, locks and seals, breakers, automatic synchronizers, disconnecting devices, and other control and protective devices as shall be designated by the Company as being required as suitable for the operation of the generator in parallel with the Company's system.

- 4. The Customer shall install and maintain a visible, manual disconnect switch. This manual switch must have the capability to be locked out by Company personnel to isolate the Company's facilities in the event of an electrical outage on the Company's transmission and distribution facilities serving the Customer. This isolating device shall also serve as a means of isolation for the Customer's equipment during any Customer maintenance activities, routine outages or emergencies. The Company shall give notice to the Customer before a manual switch is locked or an isolating device used, if possible; and otherwise shall give notice as soon as practicable after locking or isolating the Customer's facilities.
- 5. The Customer shall reimburse the Company for any equipment, factities, potential ment or upgrades required solely as a result of the installation by the Customer of generation in parallel with the Company's system.
- 6. The Customer shall notify the Company prior to the legislate energying and start-up testing of the Customer-owned generator, and the Company shall have the right to have a representative present at said test.
- 7. If harmonics, voltage fluctuations, cother disruptave problems on the Company's system are directly attributable to the operation of the Customer's system, such problem(s) shall be corrected at the Customer's sec.
- 8. No Customer's generating system shall damage the Company's system or equipment or present an undue hazare. Company personnel. The Company shall not be liable directly or indirectly for permitting or continuing to allow an attachment of a Qualifying Facility or for the acts or mission of a Customer-generator that cause loss or injury, including death, to any third party. The Customer-generator agrees to hold the Company harmless from injury or property damage incurred by any person and arising out of the ownership, operation, main tenance, or use of Customer's electrical generation facility and to indemnify the Company against all liability and expense related thereto.
- 9. Prior to installing and interconnecting a Qualifying Facility the Customer shall enter into a standard interconnection contract with the Company setting forth the conditions related to technical and safety aspects of parallel generation.
